CD 2002-10 contains the digital database for the maps Geologic and Geomorphic Features Related to Landsliding and Relative Landslide Potential with Geologic and Geomorphic Features, Redwood Creek Watershed, Humboldt County, California. GIS data include landslides, geomorphology, stream features, and geology. GIS files are in ArcInfo export format (uncompressed .e00) and ESRI shapefiles, in both Teale Albers (NAD27) and UTM Zone 10 (NAD 83) projections. Graphic files include PDF and PRN (Windows print file) formats. PDF files include the Report on the Geologic and Geomorphic Characteristics of the Redwood Creek Watershed, California, as well as a readme file and GIS metadata. The disc includes software to enable viewing of GIS data and PDF files.
