Orland High School Student advances to Regional RCD Speak-Off Competition

The Glenn County Resource Conservation District (RCD) participated in the *2010 California Association of Resource Conservation Districts (CARCD) Annual Speak-Off Contest* by holding their local high school competition October 18, 2010.

This year's topic was "*How RCD's can assist schools with natural resource education*". Students interested in agriculture, resource conservation or the environment, and in the 9th - 12th grade levels in June 2010, were able to participate for a chance to advance to the Sacramento Valley Region of RCDs competition.

1st place was awarded to sophomore student Shannon Pflum of Orland High. Pflum was awarded a certificate and \$100.00 for her winning speech which provided insight into the RCD's role in assisting with natural resource education. Her speech included some interesting thoughts regarding the types of programs that might inspire youth participation and encourage future careers in the field of natural resources.

2nd place was awarded to Brandin Jones, a senior at Orland High. Jones was awarded a certificate and \$75.00 for his speech.

Holly Anthieny, a junior at Orland High, was awarded 3rd place with a certificate and \$50.

The competition is designed to provide high school students a fun way to learn about our natural resources and gain experience in public speaking.

Pflum will speak at the Sacramento Valley Region of RCDs meeting on November 1st in Tehama County. If Pflum wins at the regional level, she will have the opportunity to represent Glenn County at the CARCD annual meeting in November, 2010 in Ventura County.
