NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Mining and Geology Board (Board) proposes to hold a public hearing in order to receive public comment on the Preliminary Review Maps of proposed revised Alquist-Priolo Earthquake Fault Zones which were released to the County of Napa, and the cities of Napa and Vallejo.

This public hearing notice is to provide the public an opportunity to present written and/or oral technical comments that may have a bearing on the proposed zone map(s) to the Board during the 90-day public comment period which commenced on July 13, 2017 and ends on October 11, 2017.

BACKGROUND

Preliminary Review Maps of proposed revised Alquist-Priolo Earthquake Fault Zones were released for the County of Napa, and the cities of Napa and Vallejo by the California Geological Survey (CGS) on July 13, 2017. These maps are released under the authority of the Alquist-Priolo Earthquake Fault Zoning (AP) Act (Public Resources Code Sections 2621 et seq.) that was passed following the 1971 San Fernando earthquake. The AP Act is a state law designed to reduce the hazard from surface fault rupture during an earthquake.

REVIEW COMMENT PERIOD

The July 13, 2017 release date begins a 90-day public comment period designed to provide the opportunity for the Board to receive technical review comments that may have a bearing on the proposed Earthquake Fault Zone maps. Written comments should be sent to the SMGB no later than October 11, 2017.

PUBLIC HEARING AND WRITTEN COMMENT

The SMGB has scheduled a public hearing to receive comments for September 21, 2017. The public hearing will take place at the Napa City Hall, City Council Chambers, 955 School Street, Napa, CA 94559 at 10:00 a.m.

The hearing facility will be barrier free in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. At the hearing, any person may present statements or arguments orally or in writing relevant to the proposed action. The SMGB requests, but does not require, that persons who make oral comments at the hearing also submit a written copy of their testimony. Comments can also be provided in writing up to ten days prior to the scheduled meeting.
