The workshop is part of an informal pre-rulemaking process for developing regulations with input from the public and stakeholders. Additionally, the comment period associated with the previous Reclamation Plan and FACE appeals pre-rulemaking workshop has been extended to coincide with this comment period. The SMGB will accept written comments on the informal pre-rulemaking workshops until March 20, 2017 at 5:00 pm. Discussion questions for the workshop can be found on the SMGB's website.
