The State Mining and Geology Board (SMGB) will conduct a public hearing to receive comments prior to considering adoption of regulations to designate areas, and terminate designated areas, of statewide or regional significance, and specify the boundaries thereof, for mineral resources lands located in the Bakersfield Production-Consumption Region, Kern County, in accordance with the Surface Mining and Reclamation Act of 1975 (SMARA), pursuant to Public Resources Code Division 2, Chapter 9, Article 6, Section 2790.
