

§ 1670. General Provisions.

The Political Reform Act ([Government Code Sections 81000, et seq.](#)), requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict-of-interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation ([2 Cal. Code of Regs. Sec. 18730](#)) which contains the terms of a standard conflict-of-interest code, which can be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing it may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of [2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730](#) and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference. This regulation and the attached Appendix designating officials and employees and establishing disclosure categories shall constitute the conflict-of-interest code of the Department of Conservation.

Designated employees shall file statements of economic interests with the Department. Upon receipt of the statements of the Director and members of the State Mining and Geology Board, the Department shall make and retain a copy and forward the originals of these statements to the Fair Political Practices Commission. Statements for all other designated employees will be retained by the Department which shall make them available for public inspection and reproduction.

*Consultants and new positions are “designated employees” for the purposes of these provisions and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the Code, subject to the following limitation: The Director may determine in writing that a particular consultant or new position, although a “designated employee,” is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. This written determination shall include a description of the consultant's or new position's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure required. The Director's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.

Department of Conservation

Disclosure Categories

Disclosure Category 1:

A designated employee in this category must report all investments, business positions, interests in real property, and sources of income, including gifts, loans and travel payments.

Disclosure Category 2:

A designated employee in this category, must report all income (including gifts, loans, and travel payments) from any business entity that provides services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment of the type used by the Department of Conservation. These employees must also report all investments and business positions in any business entity that provides services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment of the type used by the Department of Conservation.

Disclosure Category 3:

A designated employee in this category must report real property that may be affected by or subject to any provisions, guidelines, rules, regulations, or policies adopted, enforced or promulgated by the California Geological Survey, the [Office Division](#) of Mine Reclamation or the State Mining and Geology Board. A designated employee in this category must also report all investments and business positions in, and income (including gifts, loans, and travel payments) from, any business entity of the type that may be affected by or subject to any provisions, guidelines, rules, regulations, or policies adopted, enforced or promulgated by the California Geological Survey, the [Office Division](#) of Mine Reclamation, or the State Mining and Geology Board. This includes, but is not limited to, business entities of the type that are regularly engaged in: real estate development, mining, quarrying, mineral refining or smelting operations, logging operations, geothermal and petroleum development, or public utility facility development; or the manufacturing, distribution, sale, repair, or advertising of products for use in exploration, development and design criteria, and construction of facilities; or projects involving siting investigations or land use.

Disclosure Category 4:

A designated employee in this category must report real property that may be affected by or subject to any provisions, guidelines, rules, regulations, or policies adopted, enforced or

promulgated by the California Geologic Energy Management Division of Oil, Gas, & Geothermal Resources. A designated employee in this category must also report all investments and business positions in, and income (including gifts, loans, and travel payments) from, any business entity of the type that may be affected by or subject to any provisions, guidelines, rules, regulations, or policies adopted, enforced or promulgated by the California Geologic Energy Management Division of Oil, Gas, & Geothermal Resources. This includes, but is not limited to, business entities of the type that are regularly engaged in: the extraction and/or production of oil, gas or geothermal resources; or providing consulting, research or other contractual services to companies sponsoring such developments; or the manufacturing, distribution, sale, repair or advertising of products for use in exploration, development and design criteria, and construction of facilities; or projects involving siting investigations or land use.

Disclosure Category 5:

A designated employee in this category must report all investments and business positions in, and income (including gifts, loans, and travel payments) from, sources of the type that provide equipment, hardware, software, facilities, supplies, training, consulting, or services related to information technology, geographical information systems, electronic records storage, audio, video, multimedia, and telecommunications, of the type used by the Department of Conservation.

Disclosure Category 6:

A designated employee in this category must report real property that may be affected by or subject to any provisions, guidelines, rules, regulations, or policies adopted, enforced or promulgated by the Division of Land Resource Protection. A designated employee in this category must also report all investments and business positions in, and income (including gifts, loans, and travel payments) from, any source of the type that may be affected by or subject to any provisions, guidelines, rules, regulations, or policies adopted, enforced or promulgated by the Division of Land Resource Protection. This includes, but is not limited to, sources of the type that are involved in the Williamson Act program or are recipients of grants from the Division of Land Resource Protection.

Disclosure Category 7:

A designated employee in this category must report all income (including gifts, loans, and travel payments) from any business entity that provides services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment of the type used by the division in which they are employed. These employees must also report all investments and business positions in any business entity that provides services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment of the type used by their division.
