
In WellSTAR, the term 'step' may also be referred to as 'section.'

In WellSTAR, the term 'form' is the screenshot that is being viewed.

➤ The "CEQA Information" step # in WellSTAR varies with the type of CalGEM Program for which a permit or PAL approval is being requested, but the form and process is consistent throughout each CalGEM Program in WellSTAR (see chart below).







If 'State' or 'Federal' was selected for either Surface or Mineral ownership
-- Fill in the name of the agency who owns the rights.

Note: Surface ownership helps CalGEM determine the CEQA Agency Role (Lead Agency or Responsible Agency) for its CEQA reviews, while Mineral ownership does not.

For example, if the surface ownership is privately-owned, a local agency (such as Kern Co.) would issue a permit for that activity and CalGEM becomes the Responsible Agency, relying on the Kern Co. EIR for its CEQA review. If the surface ownership is federally-owned, then CalGEM would be the CEQA lead agency for its CEQA review.



CEQA Project Description & Save

In the "CEQA Project Description"

- -- provide a description of the proposed project ACTIVITY (abandon, rework, UIC, WST, etc.) that you are requesting CalGEM to approve (via a permit or PAL)
- ➤ **Note:** This is not the same as the brief project description that was provided in the "**Project Scope**," which was from the prior Kern County EIR (this is the document CalGEM relies on during our Responsible Agency CEQA review)
