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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Conservation's California Geologic Energy Management Division (CalGEM) presents this 2023 State Oil and Gas Supervisor's Report. This report is developed pursuant to Public Resources Code (PRC) section 3108, which requires the reporting of:

- a) The total amounts of oil and gas produced in each county in the state during the previous calendar year.
- b) The total cost of the division for the previous fiscal year.
- c) The total amount delinquent and uncollected from any assessments or charges levied pursuant to this chapter.

In calendar year 2023, CalGEM made progress on several fronts.

It conducted the first joint-inspections of idle wells between CalGEM, the California Air Resources Board, and the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District. CalGEM also participated in several meetings of the Methane Task Force and reported out all findings from the idle well inspections.

CalGEM also started one of its biggest initiatives – the permanent [plugging and sealing](#) of deserted or “orphan” wells across the state. Combining new state and federal funding, along with funds collected from industry, CalGEM saw an opportunity to plug wells that posed the greatest environmental and health risks. CalGEM generated a list of wells and prioritized them into three phases based on specific risk factors and criteria as well as public feedback on those plans collected through multiple online town halls and meetings with city and county governments. CalGEM also began work on the largest state-led plugging project in the Cat Canyon field in Santa Barbara County.

In early 2023, CalGEM implemented a new landmark law, Senate Bill 1137, which installed “setbacks” to prevent new oil and gas wells near residential areas. The law was implemented but then suspended on February 3 when a referendum qualified for the November 2024 ballot. It would be another 16 months before the law's opponents withdrew their measure and the law [returned to effect](#).

ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND

CalGEM prioritizes the protection of public health, safety, and the environment in its oversight of the oil, natural gas, and geothermal operations in California. To do that, CalGEM uses science and sound engineering practices to regulate the drilling, operation, maintenance, and permanent closure of energy resource wells. CalGEM also regulates certain pipelines and facilities associated with production and injection wells. These regulatory duties include conducting inspections, witnessing, reviewing tests and test results, and permitting and monitoring operations.

In 1915, the California Legislature established the Department of Petroleum and Gas as a branch of the State Mining Bureau. The initial focus of regulation was the protection of oil and gas resources in the state from production practices that could harm the ultimate level of hydrocarbon recovery. Early CalGEM regulations included well spacing requirements and authority to limit production rates. However, those regulations and the focus of CalGEM have evolved and come to prioritize the protection of public health, safety, and the environment.

In 2019, the mission of CalGEM changed to include protecting public health and safety, environmental quality, and the reduction and mitigation of greenhouse gas emissions associated with the development of hydrocarbon and geothermal resources in a manner that meets the energy needs of the state.

CalGEM Districts

CalGEM operates out of three districts to best serve the needs of the state: Northern, Central (formerly Inland), and Southern Districts.
