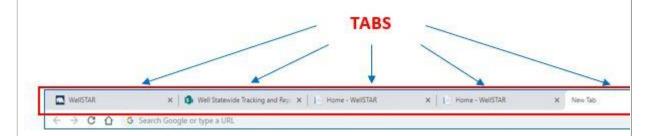
Multiple Web Browser Tabs Do's and Don'ts

Communication Purpose

The purpose of this communication is to explain the do's and don'ts of using multiple browser tabs with WellSTAR.

What is a Web Browser Tab?

A web browser allows a user to locate, access, and display web pages. WellSTAR is a web-based application, therefore is accessible via a web browser. It is possible to have more than one web browser tab open at a time as pictured below. However, there are some do's and don'ts to keep in mind.



DON'T:

Do **NOT** use multiple browser tabs to submit WellSTAR forms. The form will not process correctly.

Do:

You can use multiple browser tabs to look up or view data.
