Map Services and GIS Data

Access to Map Services

To use the map services for Important Farmland data, you need to go to the DOC Maps webpage: https://maps.conservation.ca.gov/.

Within the DOC Maps page, under Subject Areas (scroll down), choose "Agriculture". Scroll all the way to the bottom. Under Agriculturally Related Data & Maps, the second entry has Map Service listed under Access. Click on "Map Service".

The MapServer is used to view the data. Click on the service Home>services>DLRP>CaliforniaImportantFarmland_mostrecent(MapServer) in the blue box and then highlight the pathway at the top of the webpage (i.e., https://gis.conservation.ca.gov/server/rest/services/DLRP/CaliforniaImportantFar mland_mostrecent/MapServer). **Copy** the pathway.

Open ArcCatalog and, under Catalog Tree, scroll to GIS Servers. Click on GIS Servers to open the Contents pane. Click on the icon (+) next to Add ArcGIS Server to open the wizard window. Choose Use GIS Services and click Next. Next to Server URL, **paste** in the service pathway from above and press the **Finish** button to add the service. Open ArcMap. Click on the **Add Data** button (plus symbol) and scroll to GIS Servers. Click on the server on gis.conservation.ca.gov (user) service to view the folders. Open the DLRP folder, choose CalifornialmportantFarmland_mostrecent or a specific year (i.e., CalifornialmportantFarmland_2018) and click **Add**. There are also county boundaries (CalifornialmportantFarmland_countyboundaries) available to view.

Access to GIS File Geodatabases and Shapefiles

Downloadable Important Farmland GIS data in the form of ESRI File Geodatabase or Shapefiles, zipped by update year, from 1984 to the 2020 update currently in progress.

Go to the DLRP Data Downloads webpage

(https://gis.conservation.ca.gov/portal/home/group.html?id=b1494c705cb34d0 1acf78f4927a75b8f#overview) to download the GIS File Geodatabases or Shapefiles by update year. Each zipped year (i.e., 2016 FMMP shapefiles) contains all the county GIS data or shapefiles from that update year, except 2020 which is currently in progress. The 2020 update year will have counties added as they are completed by staff. Click on the update year needed (i.e., 2016 FMMP shapefiles) to open the description page. Click on the Download button on the upper right-hand side of the page to download the zipped file. The Metadata for the shapefiles is also available to view and download using the Metadata button.
