WellSTAR

In earlier publications and internal newsletter, the Division has consistently shared its vision and commitment to creating a new modern data management system to strengthen and improve oversight over California oil and gas production. Project WellSTAR is part of the plan to achieve this goal. WellSTAR is the brand given to California's implementation of the Risk Based Data Management System (RBDMS). It is a cloud based application designed to help manage information by streamlining operations, simplifying processes, providing a better way for Operators and Division to collaborate, collect and analyze data.

The development and deployment of WellSTAR will run through 2019 with various releases, each bringing incremental functionality to internal and external users. We are leveraging on the experience of the Ground Water Protection Council (GWPC) and their expertise of having implemented RBDMS successfully in 23 states to create a modern system that can adapt to the data management changes in oil and gas operations.
