

Wells Detail Page Filtering

What:

The Explore Data →Wells page now requires you to enter a filter before data will display.

Why:

This change was made to improve performance loading wells in the detail page.

Impact:


Initially the grid is blank (see example below) and therefore users may believe that data is missing:



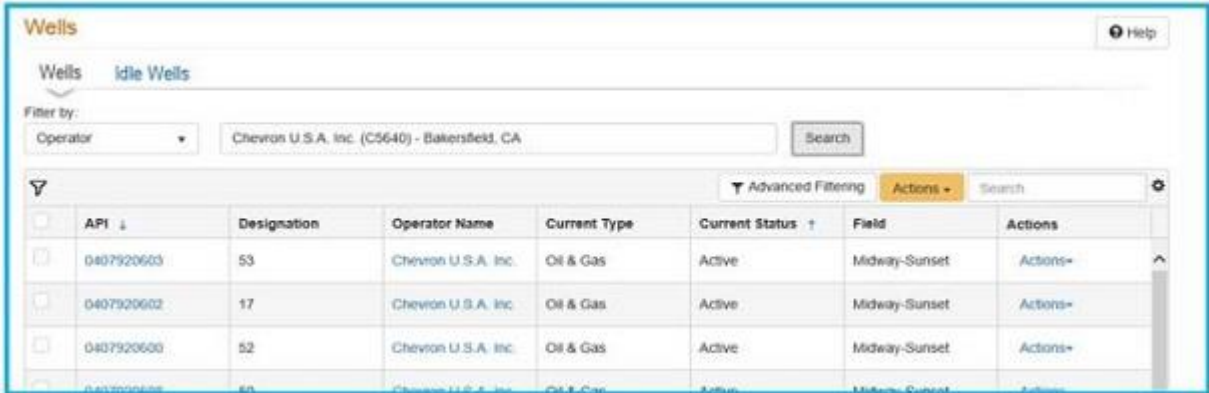
Actions to view wells:

Follow the steps below to view wells on the Well Detail page.



| Step | Action | Result |
|------|---|---|
| 1. | Choose an option from the “Filter by:” drop down menu | ‘Filter by:’ criteria choices  |
| 2. | Type requested search criteria into the “Search” box | Option in search field dropdown menu are conditional based on selection in step 1 |
| 3. | Click search | Wells that meet the selected criteria will load in the grid |
