Dear Resident,

You are receiving this mailer because the California State Department of Conservation, Geologic Energy Management Division (CalGEM) is working to permanently plug and seal oil wells in your area. In April 2026, work to permanently plug a well at 320 21st Street, Huntington Beach, CA 92648 is planned. CalGEM is a State of California regulatory agency that oversees oil wells to ensure public health and safety.

This well at 320 21st Street is known as "Golden Bee Inc./ Pursell 1." Maps of this site are on the backside of this notice. The well is located on a 2,200 square foot vacant lot on private property. It lies within a residential neighborhood bordered by homes. Work is expected to take approximately 1 month. It is anticipated that activities will be performed Monday through Friday, from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.

This effort is part of California's Project Plug, which addresses the environmental impacts of legacy wells and facilities in our communities across the state. **Scan the QR code below or go to <https://www.conservation.ca.gov/projectplug> to learn more about this project.** After the work is complete, the location is anticipated to be in a

state that poses no threat to the public or the environment.


