**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the California Department of Conservation (Department) has made a second set of revisions to the text of the proposed regulations in the rulemaking action entitled *SB 4 Well Stimulation Treatment Regulations*, regarding well stimulation treatments such as hydraulic fracturing and acid matrix stimulation. A public comment period on the originally proposed regulations was held from November 15, 2013 through January 14, 2014, pursuant to the Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action mailed to interested parties on and duly published in the *California Regulatory Notice Register* on November 15, 2013 (Register 2014, No. 46-Z, 11/15/2013). A public comment period on the first revised text of the proposed regulations was held from June 13, 2014 through July 28, 2014.

The first revisions to the originally proposed text of the regulations modified Sections 1751, 1761, 1780, 1781, 1782, 1783, 1783.1, 1783.2, 1783.3, 1784, 1784.1, 1785, 1786, 1787, 1788, and 1789, and added Sections 1777.4, 1784.2, and 1785.1 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations. The Department considers each of these revisions to be sufficiently related changes as defined in California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 42.
