NOTICE IS HERE BY GIVEN that the State Mining and Geology Board (Board) proposes to adopt California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 14, Division 2, Chapter 8, Subchapter 1, Article 17 criteria (sections 4040-4059) for exemptions from the Surface Mining and Reclamation Act of 1975 (Public Resources Code § 2710 et seq., SMARA) under Public Records Code (PRC) section 2714(f) which pertains to: "...mining operations that the Board determines to be of an infrequent nature and that involve only minor surface disturbances." The proposed regulations detail the procedures needed to apply for an exemption for surface mining operations of infrequent nature that involve minor surface disturbances. These proposed regulations also detail the administrative record, public hearing procedures, and effect of exemption determination.

January 31, 2025, opens the public comment period for the proposedPublic Resource Code 2714(f) Exemption rulemaking. The public comment period ends on March 28, 2025. Additionally, a public hearing is scheduled for March 27, 2025.
