3. Roll Call and Declaration of a Quorum

The meeting was called to order at 9:37 a.m. with Chair Kracov absent, and a guorum was declared.

Director's Report

Deputy Director, Jason Marshall, reported on the following:

- The budget process continues, and things look good for the proposals put forward.
- They are seeing more crossover between divisions within the department.
- In regards to rulemaking, he encourages the Board to continue the "pre-rulemaking" process as a means of getting input before starting the official rulemaking.
- State Geologist's Report

State Geologist, Dr. John Parrish, reported on the following:

- On November 18-19 he will attend the Consortium of Strong Motion Instrumentation (COSMOS) annual meeting in San Francisco.
- CGS will be moving from the Menlo Park campus over the next 6-8 months.
- On December 8-9 CGS will be hosting a fault displacement workshop at the Menlo Park office.
- Office of Mine Reclamation Report

Assistant Director, Pat Perez, reported on the following:

- Introduced three new hires in the reporting unit; they have begun interviewing for the remaining two administrative positions.
- The LARA program has begun, and the first two candidates are the City of San Bernardino and the City of Rialto.
- Three pre-rulemaking workshops for the inspection guidelines are scheduled for November 22 in Sacramento; November 30 in Santa Ana; and December 6 in Redding.

Member Anderson moved to approve the consent items. Member Landregan seconded and the motion carried with a roll call vote, with Member Zafir abstaining.

13. Consideration and Approval of Preliminary Rulemaking Package #2, for Financial Assurance Cost Estimate Form (PRC Section 2773.1(a)(4)).

lan Stevenson with OMR gave a brief presentation on this rulemaking package which addressed previous comments and concerns.

Member Anderson suggested that on page 2 under Wage Rates, "where applicable" be added.

Member Kenline moved to approve the FACE-1 form and instructions and directed staff to initiate rulemaking. Member Noushkam seconded and the motion carried with a unanimous roll call vote.

14. Consideration and Approval of Initiation of Rulemaking Process for Package #3, Annual Inspections (CCR Title 14, Division 2, Chapter 8, Subchapter 1, Article 1, Section 3504.5). Nicholas Lash presented the rulemaking package and the proposed timeline.

Member Lane moved to initiate the pre-rulemaking process. Member Noushkam seconded and the motion carried with Member Anderson voting against.

15. Consideration and Approval of Request for Exemption from SMARA per PRC Section 2714(f) for the Sycamore Road Agricultural Mining Project, Ventura County and consideration of CEQA categorical exemption (CCR Title 14, Chapter 3, Article 18, Sections 15304, 15305). John Hecht with Sespe Consulting presented an overview of the project and the reason for the exemption request.

Member Noushkam moved to approve the exemption request. Member Kenline seconded and the motion carried with a 5-2 roll call vote, with Members Lane and Zafir voting against the motion.
